Meeting called by glc action group.

Reports from areas.

Reports were heard from West Hampstead, Burton St., Drummond St. Islington, Kilburn, Maida Hill, Charring on St. & Chiswick. Reports of harrasment from councils; particularly in Chiswick, where the council has cut off all services, gas, water, electricity, to squatters in five houses (mainly families, & including 30 children). The squatters, however are resisting all attempts to intimidate them, and are determined to fight on.

Reported on Press Conference to be held to answer glc's lying and slanderous attacks on the squatting movement. A full report will be given at next ALSF meeting.

Fraturdays FSAS meeting decided to change the name of the organisation to ADVISORY SERVICE for SQUATTERS (ASS) To avoid giving the impression that they only deal with families. ALSF Working Group.

THIS group was set up at the last ALSF meeting to discuss methods of making ALS a more effective force. Among its' recommendations were:

1. That ALSF should have its' own office & phone.
2. That ALSF should try to reach a greater number of squatters by being present at local demo's, pickets, etc. and by co-ordinating with other groups active in the Housing struggle.

3. That a one-day ~~EVENT~~ EVENT comprising a Conference/Rally/Demo/ Benefit Concert/Exhibition be arranged, and that aforementioned EVENT be FUN. A lot of enthusiasm was felt for this idea, and the Working group will meet Thurs 30th Jan at Drummond St at 7.30 pm to discuss further action.

It was proposed that ALSF should have a contingent at the BLOODY SUNDAY RALLY on Saturday 1st Feb, Hyde Park 3pm, and that the ALS banner be taken. Also proposed that all future ALSF meetings to be held fortnightly at the 'Roebuck'. Both proposals passed unanimously.
